



Process: 2009-10 Tuition and Mandatory Fees

- November February: Discussions with CPE staff
- March 6: CPE set tuition ceilings/recommendations
- March 10: UK Board of Trustees approves tuition and fees rates
- May 22: CPE approves institutions' full schedule of tuition rates
- June 9: UK Board of Trustees approves 2009-10 university budget, including program and course fees




UK and Top 20 Institutions


